Introducing the "Libero" Without Fuss and Bother

Each school would provide scrimmage vests (pinnies) of a different color -1 for each team.

No libero tracker would be necessary – each school would be on the honor system. Referees would be asked to be lenient as teams try to figure out what they are doing!

Basic Libero Rules:

- 1. The libero is a backrow player. They may not serve, block, or complete an attack from above the height of the net.
- 2. The same player should be the libero throughout an entire game.
- 3. The libero may switch with any back row player. This is called a "replacement" and does not count as a substitution. A libero cannot play front row.
- 4. The libero can only be replaced by the player that she went in for.
- 5. There must be at least one rally between libero replacements. A serve starts a rally.
- 6. The libero replacement occurs on the sideline between the attack line and the endline.
