## Introducing the “Libero” Without Fuss and Bother

Each school would provide scrimmage vests (pinnies) of a different color – 1 for each team.

No libero tracker would be necessary – each school would be on the honor system. Referees would be asked to be lenient as teams try to figure out what they are doing!

### Basic Libero Rules:

1. The libero is a backrow player. They may not serve, block, or complete an attack from above the height of the net.
2. The same player should be the libero throughout an entire game.
3. The libero may switch with any back row player. This is called a “replacement” and does not count as a substitution. A libero cannot play front row.
4. The libero can only be replaced by the player that she went in for.
5. There must be at least one rally between libero replacements. A serve starts a rally.
6. The libero replacement occurs on the sideline between the attack line and the endline.
