Lincoln Catholic Athletic League Policies:

For any questions or concerns on these policies, please contact the League Director.

Admission Cost: Volleyball and Boys & Girls Basketball

\$3 per person (Schools may charge less, for promotional reasons, if they desire.)

FREE - Pre-School and under

\$10 Maximum - per family (immediate family only)

Coaches Pass:

Coaches passes will not longer be given. If you are a coach please inform the gate-keeper upon arrival, and free admission for you and your immediate family will be had. Any abuse of this policy may result in permanent suspension from the league.

Referee Payment:

Volleyball and Basketball: \$40 per game per official Basketball Single Game Sites: \$45 per game per official Volleyball Single Game Sites: \$50 per game per official

Weather Protocol:

The Lincoln Catholic Athletic League needs to maintain a standard protocol when an issue of weather arises. Traditionally, cancellation of events has been based off the decision of Lincoln Public Schools both for school and for extracurricular events. If Lincoln Public Schools close school, Lincoln Catholic Schools follow suit. The same has been true for the Lincoln Catholic Athletic League. If Lincoln Public Schools cancel athletic events, the Lincoln Catholic Athletic League will also cancel athletic events.

In the event of questionable weather, the Lincoln Catholic Athletic League <u>may</u> follow the decision of Lincoln Public Schools. The decision of the cancelation of events will be determined by 2 p.m. of that day. Moreover, the League Director reserves the right, to overturn the decision of Lincoln Public Schools for events in the Lincoln Catholic Athletic League. In the event that the Lincoln Public Schools are not in session, then the League Director will make the decision.

Parents are to be informed at the beginning of the year that they, of course, make the final decision as to whether their children participate or not, due to weather conditions, and that their children will not be penalized in any way by a decision not to participate.

In the event of the first cancelation in a sports season (excluding Track and Cross Country), the Lincoln Catholic Athletic League will not reschedule this missed event. If a second event in the same sports season is cancelled, the League Director will attempt to reschedule this event within two weeks of the end of the season. If the event cannot be rescheduled within two weeks of the end of the regular season, this event will be cancelled.

Meetings:

All Athletic Directors are required to attend all meetings, arranged by the League Director. If the Athletic Director is unable to attend, that Athletic Director shall send a representative from his/her school to attend the meeting, in his/her place. Failure to have an approved excused absence and a representative for your school will result in a fine to that school of \$100.00, payable to: Catholic Bishop's League.

Forfeit:

If a school's team does not have a sufficient (legal) number of players at the start of the scheduled game, that game will be declared a forfeit. That school will be billed the reimbursement of officials for that game to the hosting school. An unofficial game may still be played, as long as each team's coach and referees are in agreement of the circumstance.

Team Count & Roster Deadlines: (Extensions may be granted at the discretion from the League Director)

Team counts and rosters must be submitted to the League Director <u>by the date and time requested</u>. If an Athletic Director fails to submit his/her school's team count or roster by the deadline, said school will not be allowed to participate in the season's activities.

Schedule:

Each school will be given a one week time period to review each season's sports schedule prior to it being made public on the Lincoln Catholic Athletic League website. If a school requires a change to the schedule due to that school's negligence in reviewing the sports schedule after the final schedule has been made public via the Lincoln Catholic Athletic League website: cysi.org, a \$100.00 penalty fine will be billed to that school.

Technical Foul:

Athletic Directors must report all technical fouls to the League Director within 24 hours of occurrence.

Athletes:

If a player receives a technical foul, he/she will be removed from competition for the remainder of the half. If a player receives an additional technical foul in the same game he/she will be suspended for the remainder of the season.

If throughout the course of the season an athlete receives two (2) technical fouls, he/she will be suspended for the remainder of the season.

Coaches:

If a coach receives a technical foul, he/she will be automatically ejected from the game and asked to leave the school grounds. Refusal to leave school grounds, will result in said coach being permanently suspended from the Catholic Youth Sports League.

If a coach receives two (2) technical fouls, in one season, he/she will be suspended from coaching for the remainder of the school year. A written request to coach, in the future, will need to be proposed to the League Director and accepted before reinstatement is had.

Parents & Spectators:

If a parent or student in the stands receives a technical foul, he/she will be ejected from the game and asked to leave school grounds. Refusal to leave school grounds will result in a permanent suspension from all Catholic Youth Sports competitions.
